Anne Brewer has been in education for thirteen years. Anne's interest in education began when she was in high school and had the opportunity to volunteer in a kindergarten classroom to earn her Gold Award in Girl Scouts. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Middle School Education with an emphasis in math and science from the University of Cincinnati.
