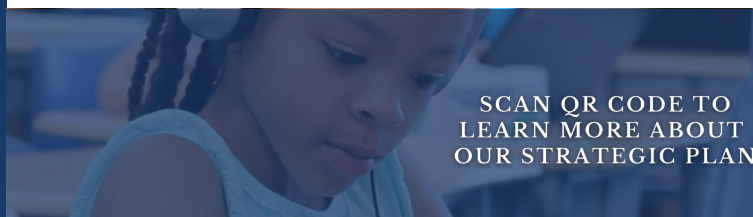

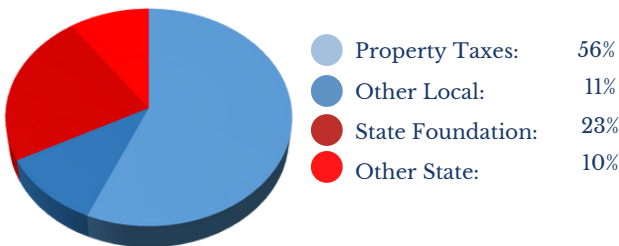

NWLSD EXPENDITURE PER PUPIL: \$9,845

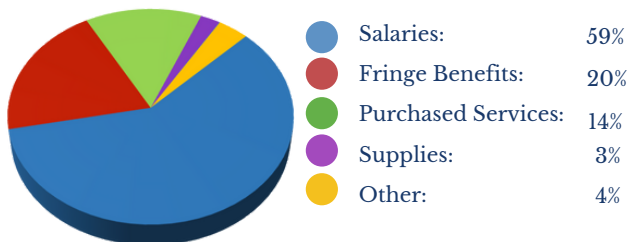
